Letter held by Cllr Sturgess. Copy letter 16 March 1951 from Secretary to the Bishop of Clifton where the Bishop gives consent for NPC to take over the plot of land at Nympsfield known as the "Barrows". This is a consent that the NPC can take over maintenance. Ownership has not formally transferred and remains with the Bishop of Clifton (assuming the Church is the owner) unless NPC can show adverse possession.

Deed held by Cllr Sturgess. Original Deed of Gift dated 14 August 1956 between The Stroud Brewery Co Ltd & others (1) and the Parish Council of Nympsfield (2) - 16 feet x 13 feet - plan shows the area of land which is the position of the bus shelter. Also Epitome of Title (marked as compared) but no plans.

Licence held by Cllr Sturgess. 2 March 1977 Licence from West County Breweries Limited to the Parish Council of Nympsfield - licence to affix and maintain a high level street light at the R&C. There is an obligation to pay a yearly sum of 10 pence (if demanded) - the licence would continue until withdrawn/revoked. Change of ownership has likely ended licence in any event.
